We are excited to announce the opening of an additional food bank at Restoration Foursquare, 6700 Martin Way E, Olympia, WA. Loren Williams piloted this new outlet with Pastor John Kitterman and John Johnsen. There is a methadone clinic next door as well as several low income housing areas near by. Word has it that this food bank is greatly needed in this area. Jennifer Johnsen, a nutritionist at the church, has offered to supply healthy recipes each time. Their first date was June 24th, based on numbers of people per family represented, 99 people were fed. The dates will be the 4th Tuesday of each month.
