Botswana, Africa. Pastor James was a student of Matt. When he first met James he was working as a specialized police officer protecting diplomats and government officials. It was a good job with financial security, but God had called James to be a pastor and to plant churches. He began correspondence courses while he worked as a police officer. Matt says he was one of the most disciplined and persevering students he had ever worked with. James worked diligently for 6 years to complete his bachelor's degree in Bible and Theology. After James completed his program of study he resigned his job and was posted to a rural area in the Southern part of Botswana. He has planted 2 churches and pastors both of them. Matt was able to minister one of his churches and found nearly 200 passionate believers packed into a makeshift church. James is planning to start a 3rd church. Matt & Debbie thank you for helping them be a part of Pastor James' life and others like him to reach Botswana with the Gospel.

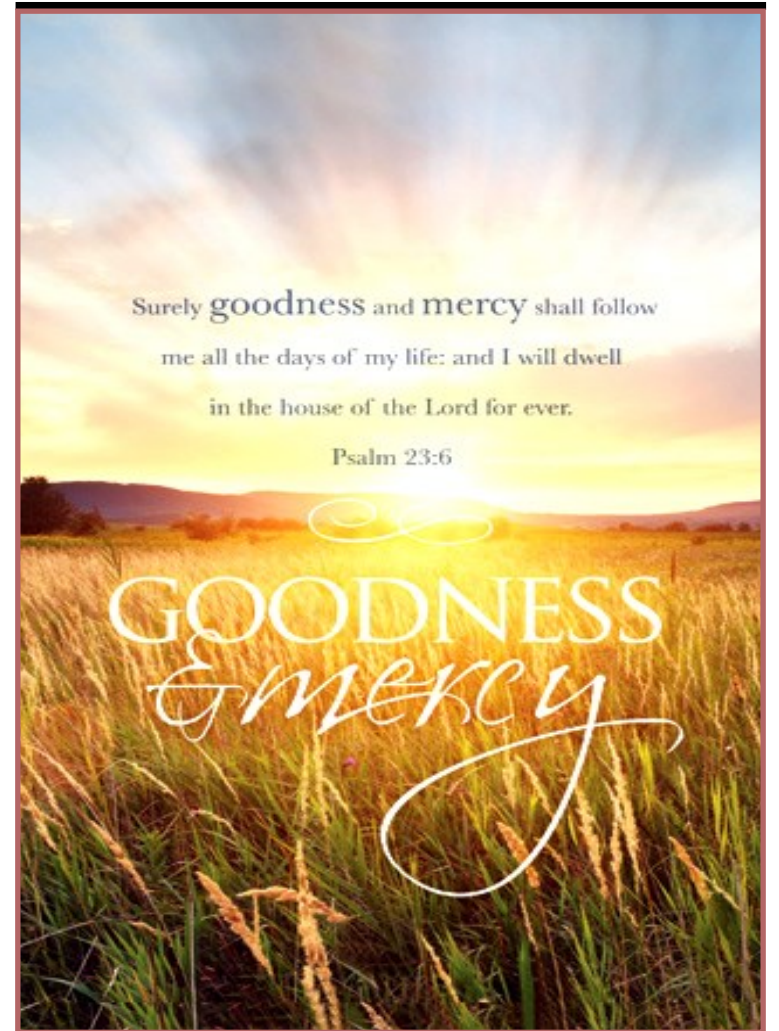

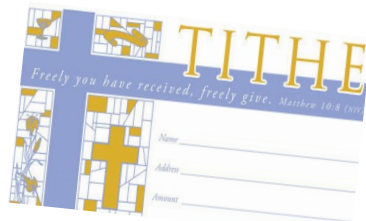
