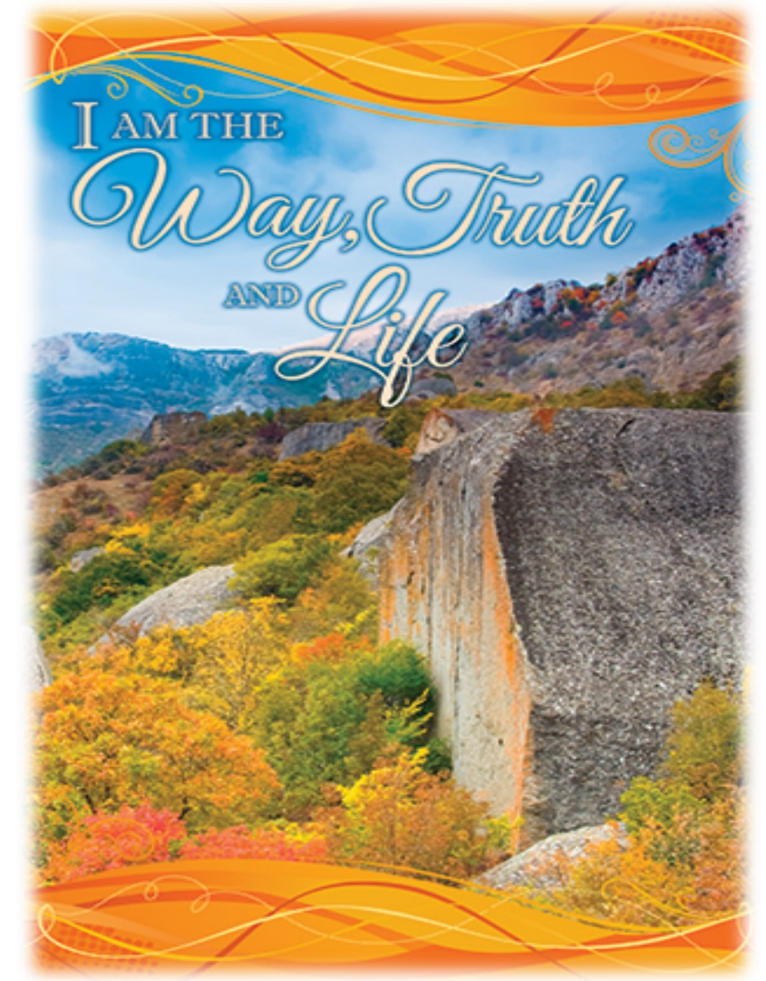

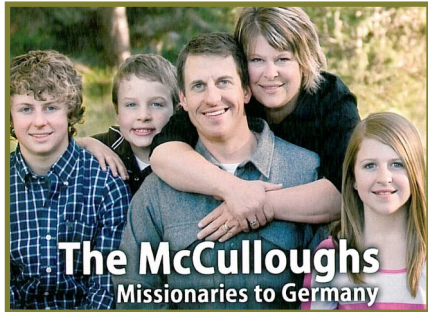
We welcome you today...

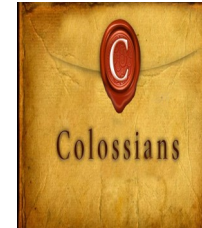
