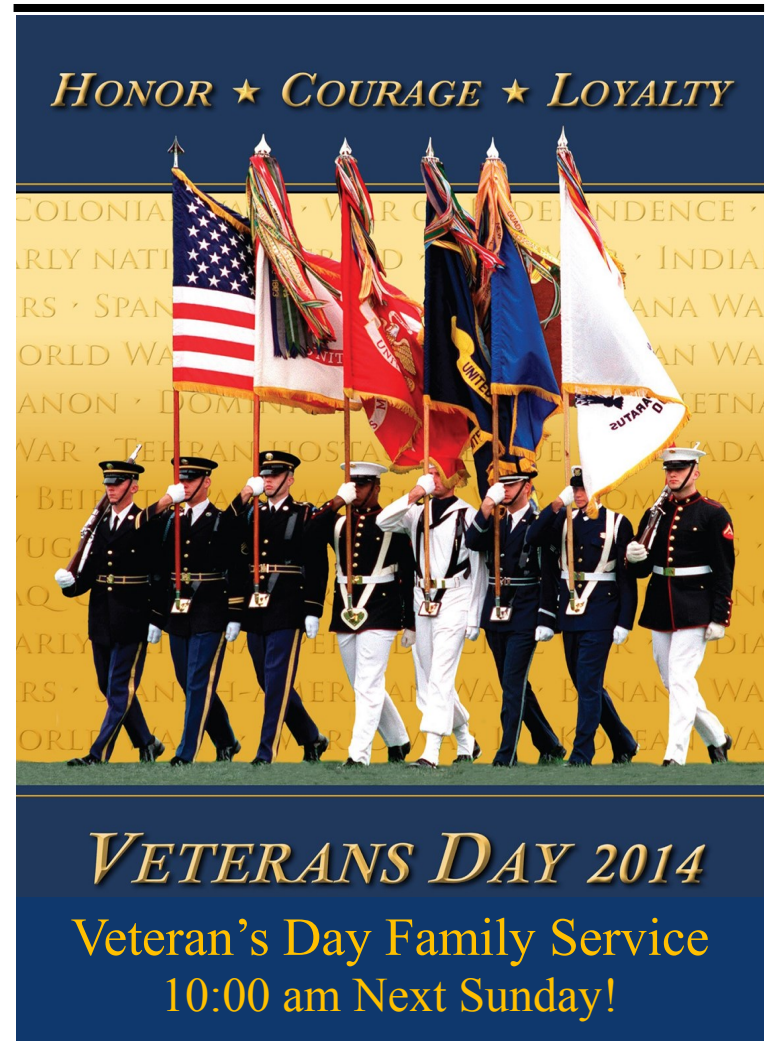

Your chefs Bob & Warren will be serving ham, eggs, hash browns, muffins, coffee and juice.

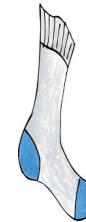
