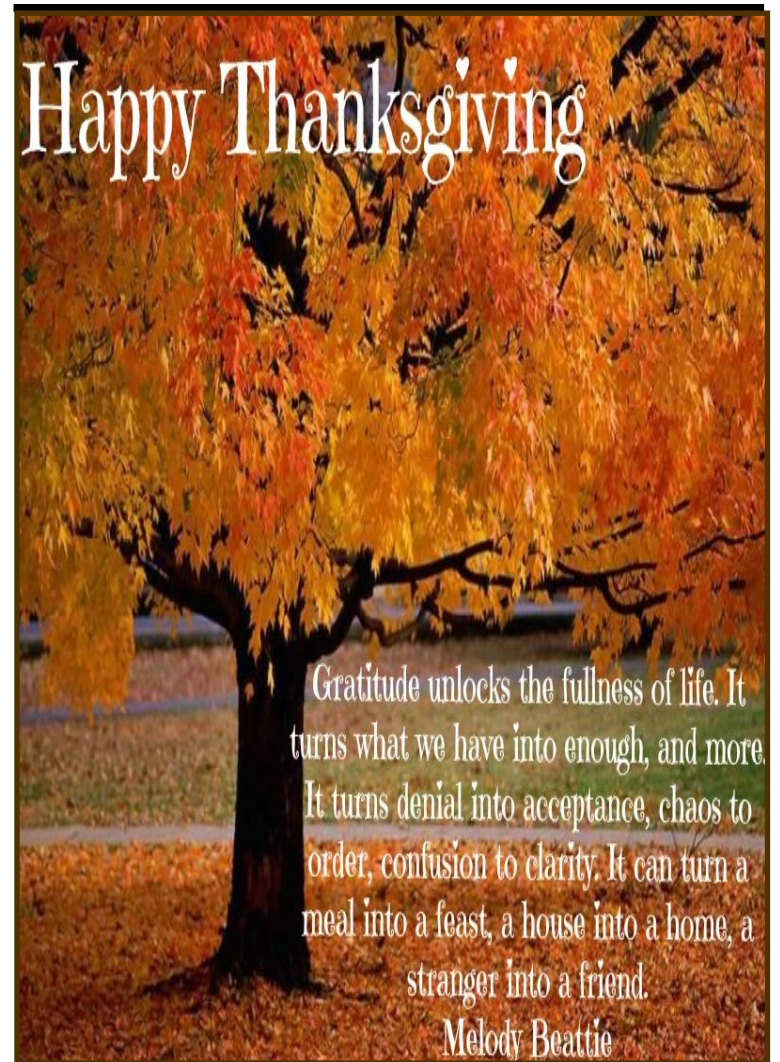

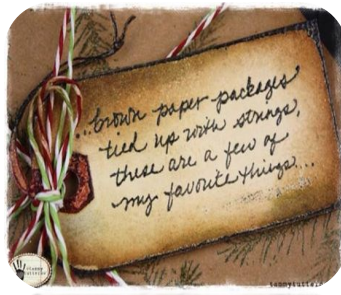

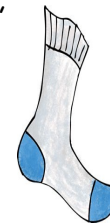


**Men's Breakfast & Tool Exchange
