We need lots of individually wrapped candy for this community outreach! You may begin to bring candy to the office now.



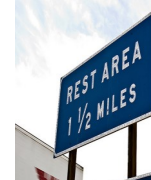

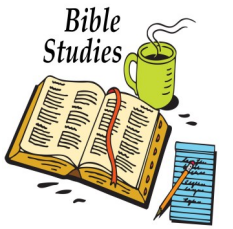
