- 1) September’s **Monthly English Circle** is on Friday the 8<sup>th</sup>. Pray for hearts to be opened to the gospel. Ann’s ladies’ and moms and tots’ classes also resume on September 11<sup>th</sup>. Since our outreach in July, **Mr. Masaaki K.** has been attending our Japanese bible study and worship service on Sunday mornings. He has had other exposure to Christianity as well. Pray that he will seriously seek God and entrust his life to Him. Pray for another non-Christian, **Mr. Toyosaki**, who often attends worship with his believing wife, though they always leave immediately after the service.
- 2) Pray for our **Sunday worship** in English and **Japanese Bible study time**. I preach on September 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 3) Pray for Ann Little and Ai Nightingale as they start a Japanese **Sunday School** for our 2-5 year-olds on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sundays of each month (begins Sept. 10<sup>th</sup>).
