Armistice Day was established with a proclamation by President Woodrow Wilson which reads in part: "Armistice Day will be filled with solemn pride in heroism of those who died in the country's service and with gratitude for the victory, both because of the thing from which it has freed us and because of the opportunity it has given America to show her sympathy with peace and justice in the councils of the nations." On June 1, 1954, Armistice Day was renamed Veterans Day to honor all U.S. veterans.

Every year, on November 11, we honor America's veterans for their patriotism and willingness to serve and sacrifice for our nation's common good. This Veteran's Day, let us remember and honor all of those men and women who gave themselves, and let us continue to pray for those currently serving.



With thanksgiving around the corner, let's take a moment to give thanks to those men and women who worked so hard to contribute and build this beautiful church. Continuing to care for the building, property has repaired the following items in the month of October:

Electrical Repairs: timers, plugs, wiring, and lights.

Sanctuary:

The steel beams were painted inside and out.

All of the pews and office chairs were re-upholstered; cushions were made for the chapel.

All of the spider webs in the dome were cleaned out.

The carpet in the sanctuary and in the office was cleaned.

The piano and organ were removed due to termite damage.

Pastor's Office:

A damaged window was replaced and the outside wood was painted.

One book shelf was removed.

One wall was painted with accent color.

New desk light.

Robinson Hall & Sunday School Building:

The building was tented/fumigated for termites and any exterior damaged wood was replaced and/or painted.

All of the damaged wood in the stair wells was replaced and painted.


A cement border was placed around Robinson Hall to prevent more damage.

The kitchen cabinets were re-finished and the old knobs were cleaned and polished. Twenty four year old knobs look brand new!
