

PART 6 -UNFINISHED: STUDY QUESTIONS

LUKE 22: 54-62

ICE-BREAKER: Have you ever felt uncomfortable, unfit, unprepared or just wanted to “blend in” when you have had an opportunity to share your Faith? Why?

1.- **READ:** **Matthew 16: 18-19, Matthew 7: 24-25, Psalm 18:2**

Jesus had called Peter, “the Rock”. We usually think of rocks as being pretty solid, yet 3 times in a row, Peter denied even knowing Jesus.

- How do you think Peter felt?
- Why do you suppose that after that event happened, it is NEVER again mentioned in the New Testament? How is that different from the world’s point of view?
- What does that say about God’s forgiveness and HOW we should deal with regret?

2.- **READ:** **Romans 8:1-2, Timothy 1:7, Isaiah 43:18, and Romans 3:23-25**

We should never think that we are not “good enough” to share the Gospel of Christ. God used “Unfinished” people like David, who was an adulterer and a murderer (**Read 2 Samuel 11:2-17**) and Saul (later Paul), who could have been considered a terrorist (**Read Acts 9:1-2 & Galations 1: 13-14**), as well as Peter, who denied Christ, as men of His choice to carry out His ministry.

- Why do you think that using “unfinished” people was, and still is, a part of God’s plan to spread The Good News?
- How can He use us, in our unfinished state, in His ministry?
- How is God a “God of do-overs”?

Read: **EPHESIANS 2: 1-10**

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
