The final stage 4 will see the end of the stay-at-home order with the reopening of the "highest risk parts of our economy" being reopened, Newsom said on Twitter. That includes concerts, convention centers and sports with live crowds. Newsom said that stage would come only "once therapeutics have been developed."
