1. God's shaking will reveal God's <u>glory</u>.

²⁰ The word of the Lord came to Haggai a second time on the twentyfourth day of the month: ²¹ "Tell Zerubbabel governor of Judah that I will shake the heavens and the earth. ²² I will overturn the royal thrones and shatter the power of the foreign kingdoms. I will overthrow chariots and their drivers; horses and their riders will fall, each by the sword of his brother. Haggai 2:20-22

⁶ This is what the Lord Almighty says: "In a little while I will once more shake the heavens and the earth, the sea and the dry land. ⁷ I will shake all nations, and the desired of all nations will come, and I will fill this house with glory," says the LORD Almighty. ⁹ The glory of this present house will be greater than the glory of the former house," says the LORD Almighty. 2. God's shaking will launch God's eternal <u>reign</u>.


