◆ **Oknēros (*ok-nā-ro’s*):**sluggish, slothful, lazy,
backward, lagging in diligence

So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God. 1 Corinthians 10:31

Whatever you do, work at with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, Colossians 3:23

2. I commit to keeping my passion hot ____.

◆ **Zeō (*ze’-ō*):**to boil with heat, to be enthusiastic,
bubbly, intense passion

It is fine to be zealous, provided the purpose is good, and to be so always, not just when I am with you. Galatians 4:18
