

## Ministry Gifts (Ephesians 4:11; 1 Corinthians 12:28-29)

Gift	Definition	Contributes
Apostleship Apostolos (ä-po'-sto-los)	The divine ability to start churches or other ministries and oversee their development. The ability to minister cross-culturally with the goal of planting churches.	New Ministries
Prophecy Prophēteia (pro-fā-tā'-ä)	The divine ability to proclaim God's truth with power and clarity in a timely and culturally sensitive manner. The focus is for correction, repentance, or edification. It's the ability to reveal God's Word accurately.	Conviction
Evangelism Euaggelistēs (yü-än-ge-lēs-tā's)	The divine ability to be an unusually effective instrument in leading unbelievers to a saving knowledge of Christ. Some with this gift are most effective in personal evangelism, while others may be used by God in group evangelism or cross-cultural evangelism.	Gospel "Good News"
Pastor/Shepherding-Teaching Poimēn/Didaskalos (poi-mā'n)/ (dē-dä'-skä-los)	The divine ability to lead, nourish, protect, and personally care for the needs of a "flock" of believers while simultaneously being able to teach and "feed" the flock.	Nurture & Growth
Teaching Didaskalos (dē-dä'-skä-los)	The divine enablement to understand and give detailed explanation of biblical truth. Ability to search out and validate truth which has been presented.	Application
Miracles Dynamis (dü'-nä-mēs)	The divine ability to serve as an instrument through whom God accomplishes acts that manifest supernatural power.	God's Power

Gift	Definition	Contributes
Gifts of Healing Iama (ē'-ä-mä)	The divine ability to be God's vessel for restoring people to wholeness. People with this gift: demonstrate the power of God; bring restoration to the sick and diseased; pray, touch, or speak words that miraculously bring healing to one's body.	Wholeness
Helps Antilēmpsis (än-tē'-lām-psēs)	The divine ability to bring support and help to someone in the performing of a task in order to relieve their burden and responsibilities.	Support
Administration Kybernēsis (kü-be'r-nā-sēs)	The divine ability to steer a church or Christian organization toward the fulfillment of its goals by managing its affairs and implementing necessary plans.	Efficiency & Effectiveness
Tongues Glōssa (glō's-sä)	The divine ability given spontaneously by the Holy Spirit to an individual to speak in a language unknown to the speaker.	A Message

## Manifestation Gifts (1 Corinthians 12:8-10)

Gift	Definition	Contributes
Wisdom Sophia (so-fē'-ä)	The divine ability to apply the principles of God's Word in a practical way to specific situations and then to recommend the best course of action at the best time.	Guidance
Knowledge Gnōsis (gnō'-sēs)	The divine ability to discover and analyze and systemize truth for the benefit of others. But the word of knowledge can also involve supernatural perception and discernment for the purpose of ministering to others.	Awareness
Faith Pistis (pē'-stēs)	The divine ability to see what others cannot see and to trust God in the midst of difficult circumstances.	Confidence

Gift	Definition	Contributes
Healing Iama (ē'-ā-mā)	The divine ability to cause a complete and instantaneous physical healing by direct command and/or touch.	Wholeness
Miracles Dynamis (dü'-nä-mēs)	The divine ability to perform supernatural acts which clearly demonstrate God's power as being greater than Satan.	God's Power
Prophecy Prophēteia (pro-fā-tā'-ä)	The divine ability to proclaim God's truth to others without compromise or explanation, resulting in edification, exhortation, and comfort for the believer and conviction for the non-believer.	Conviction
Discernment Diaeresis (dē-ä'-krē-sēs)	The divine ability to discern the spirit of truth from the spirit of error.	Clarity
Tongues Glōssa (glō's-sä)	The divine ability to receive and impart a spiritual message in a language the recipient has never learned so that other members of the body may be edified. This message must be interpreted either by the recipient or by another person with the Gift of Interpretation.	A Message
Interpretation of Tongues Hermēneia Glōssōn (her-mā-nā'-ä glō's-ōn)	This is the divine ability to translate in a language the recipient doesn't know.	A Message
