

Love & Respect

Couples will learn how to resolve conflict, deal with negative reactions, and motivate each other by meeting each other's needs in this 6 week study. Couples are encouraged to attend together, however, singles are welcome. (Tuesdays 6:30-8:30pm)

Parenting: The Early Years

Class participants will take a look at the ten traits children remember in their parents. (Mondays 6-7pm)

Man Class

Help men discover what it takes to be a good dad, father and person. (Mondays 5:00-6:00)

Childbirth Education

Class participants will learn the necessary information needed for labor and delivery. They also receive education about breastfeeding. Expectant mothers are encouraged to attend with a birthing partner. (Tuesdays 6-8pm)

Jumpstart Training for Pregnancy

A class held each month to help Mother and Father during the early stages of pregnancy. Participants learn about what to expect in the beginning, healthy nutrition and pregnancy safety. (The last?? of each month from 10 am-12pm)

COACHING

Trained PSC Coaches guide clients through a personalized process that helps them look at their past and present in order to envision a greater future.


