

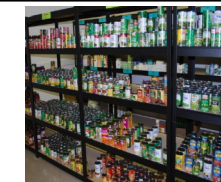
Calling All Prayer Warriors!

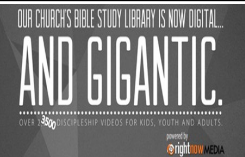

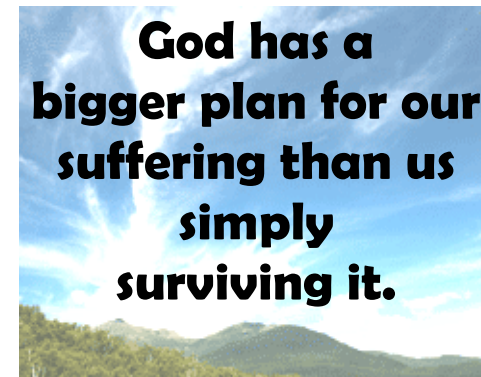
