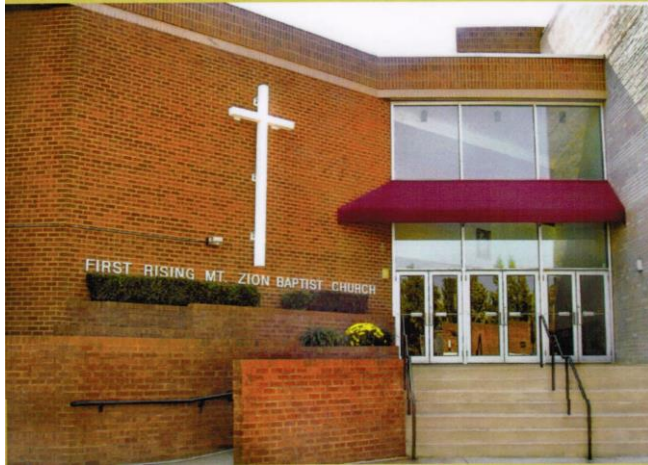

CHURCH HISTORICAL NOTE: On December 13, 1936, First Rising Mount Zion Baptist Church(FRMZ) was organized by the following ten (10) committed pioneers; Daisy Ball, John Ball, Eva Brooks, Eva Cook, William Cook, William Foster, Bessie Galloway, Julia Jeffers, Rev. E. Lucas, and Lillie Tucker. And five months later; on May 26, 1937, they selected their first pastor in the person of Rev. George E. Galloway of First Rising Mount Zion Baptist Church. This official beginning in the month of May marks the annual Anniversary celebration of the Church and Pastor of each year since 1937.
