

E. Lucas, and Lillie Tucker. And five months later; on May 26, 1937, they selected their first pastor in the person of Rev. George E. Galloway of First Rising Mount Zion Baptist Church. This official beginning in the month of May marks the annual Anniversary celebration of the Church and Pastor of each year since 1937.
