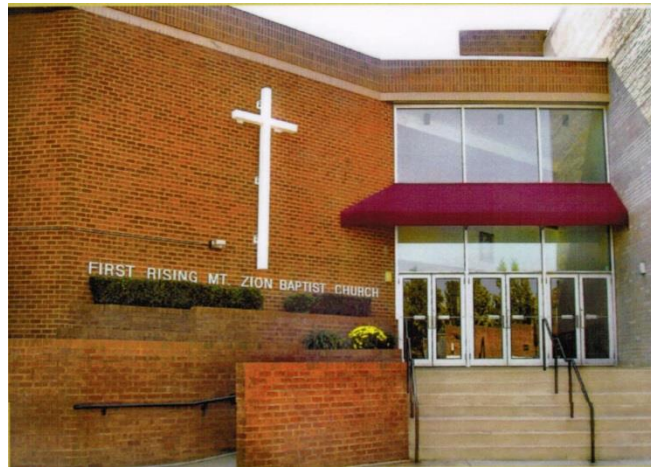

**CHURCH HISTORICAL NOTE #5:** Rev. Ernest R. Gibson attended Randall Junior High School in Southwest, Washington, D.C., where he was born and raised. He graduated from Armstrong High School and pursued his secondary education at Miner's Teachers College, the Washington Baptist Seminary, and The American University. At the age of twenty-four (24), on February 10, 1944, he married the love of his life in the person of Ms. Etta Mae Colding while subsequently serving in the United States Navy during World War II. His marriage to Ms. Colding was blessed with three beautiful children: Ernest Robinson, Jr., Delores Marie, and Mark Edward. The family later grew to include two nieces and a nephew: Bessie Mae Colding, Virginia Colding Nesmith, and Frederick Beecher Colding. Rev. Ernest R. Gibson's love abounds in the support of his immediate family and an extended family. This act exemplifies the man that provided service to the congregation of First Rising Mount Zion Baptist Church for forty-six (46) years faithfully. (To be continued).
