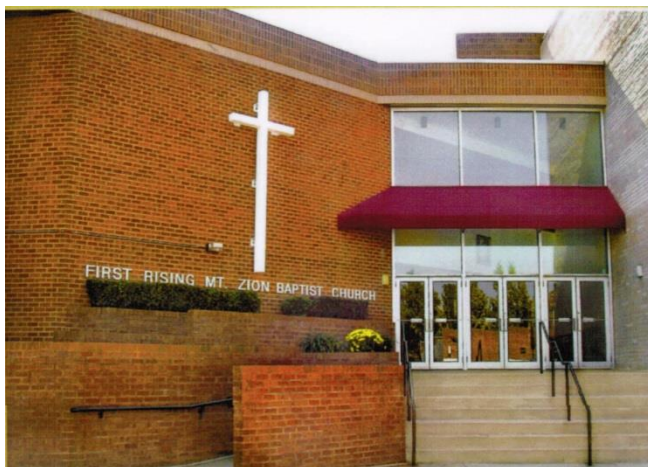

CHURCH HISTORICAL NOTE # 10: His" LEGACY" lives! The Rev. Ernest R. Gibson's legacy lives not only because of the site where the First Rising Mount Zion Baptist Church has been on the corner of Sixth and N Street N. W. for the past sixty-two (62) years and in existence for a total of eighty (80) years but rather because of his leadership and recognition throughout the city and nation. He received the Humanitarian Award from the Seymour House at Howard University (1980), the Public Service Award from the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) 1982, and served as Co-Chairman of the Metropolitan Washington Billy Graham Crusade in 1986. And yet, his biggest challenge was on the horizon with the financing and building of a new church home for the First Rising Mount Zion Baptist Church's congregation. (To Be Continued).
