

Rev. Oran W. Young is a native Washingtonian with maternal and paternal roots from North and South Carolina, respectively. He is the oldest of four sons born to Anna Belle and the late John W. Young, Jr. His brothers are Gerald (Deacon), Kevin, and Joe (deceased). He was reared as a Baptist by his parents, but with adulthood came a more mature and in-depth study of the Bible which helped him discover the truth for himself.

Educated in the D. C. School System, he graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School and furthered his education at the University of the District of Columbia, where he graduated with honors and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Elementary Education.
