Rev. Oran W. Young is a native Washingtonian with maternal and paternal roots from North and South Carolina, respectively. He is the oldest of four sons born to Anna Belle and the late John W. Young, Jr. His brothers are Gerald (Deacon), Kevin, and Joe (deceased). He was reared as a Baptist by his parents, but with adulthood came a more mature and in-depth study of the Bible which helped him discover the truth for himself.

Educated in the D. C. School System, he graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School and furthered his education at the University of the District of Columbia, where he graduated with honors and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Elementary Education. This prepared him for his first career, a school teacher in the D.C. Public Schools where he taught fourth graders. For eighteen summers, Rev. Young worked in the D.C. Department of Recreation as a Day Camp Counselor and Director where he managed and trained counselors to lead a variety of camp activities for children from the ages of seven to thirteen.

Maintaining his focus on serving people, Rev. Young operates a financial service practice which allows him to analyze the financial needs of his clients and make recommendations that will help them meet their estate, college and retirement goals.

Rev. Young accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Saviour and joined Israel Baptist Church where he served in numerous capacities including the Men's Ministry President, member of the Men's Choir, Sunday School Teacher, Deacon, Facilitator of the Evangelism Ministry, Treasurer, and co-leader of the Couples Ministry. God was preparing him for the Ministry. When the Call came, like so many before him, he ran from his calling to preach. But the journey leading to this time and place in his life, the desire to serve and be a "true" follower of Jesus Christ, affirmed that he accept the Call. While gaining clarity on his calling to the Gospel Ministry, Rev. Young pursued a Master of Divinity Degree at the Howard University School of Divinity.

In September, 2001, Rev. Young preached his Initial Sermon and was licensed to preach by his Pastor, Rev. Dr. Morris L. Shearin of Israel Baptist Church. In 2005, he earned his Master of Divinity Degree from the Howard University School of Divinity. He was ordained by Rev. Dr. Shearin in August, 2006 as a Minister of the Gospel. In August, 2009, after the Lord cleared the way, Rev. Young accepted the offer from the Pastor of New Redeemer Baptist Church, Rev. Alan Thompson, to serve as Assistant to the Pastor. He served until May, 2016. On April 9, 2016, Rev. Young was called to serve as the Pastor of First Rising Mt. Zion Baptist Church in Washington, D. C. On the First Sunday in June, 2016, Rev. Young began his journey with First Rising Mt. Zion. He brings his ability to love and serve people, his gifts of teaching, preaching, wisdom and his organizational skills.

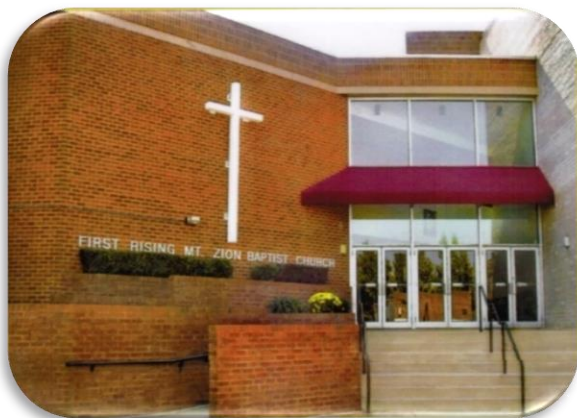
