CHURCH HISTORICAL NOTE #28: Since January 14, 1952, until March 29, 2003, First Rising Mount Zion worshipped under the leadership of one elected pastor for fifty-one (51) years. However; with the election of Rev. Raymond C. Bell on March 29, 2003, a new beginning was set in motion for First Rising Mount Zion Baptist Church. Rev. Bell was born May 29, 1960, in Beaumont Texas. Rev. Bell came to First Rising Mount Zion full of life and promise. Under Rev. Bell's leadership, the church's organization structure was changed to help members to distinguish between church work and the work of the church. As a result, all clubs and auxiliary organizations were known as ministries and grouped under the umbrella of individual councils. In addition, Midday Prayer Meeting and Bible Institute was added to the schedule of weekly activities. On March 1, 2004, the church paid off the mortgage on the sanctuary. By 2005, the church expanded its evangelism and outreach efforts by participating in the DC Festival which was a citywide evangelism event and by becoming a member of the Downtown Cluster of Congregations, as well as organizing the Cancer Support Ministry, the Life Recovery Ministry, and the annual Community Affair. And yet, after nine (9) years under the leadership of Rev. Raymond C. Bell; on January 7, 2012, the Board of Deacons Ministry, in accordance with the church's Constitution and By-laws, declared the pulpit vacant. (To Be Continued).
