

CHURCH HISTORICAL NOTE # 37: Rev. Reginald M. Green; Civil Rights icon, distinguished Pastor for over forty (40) years within the Washington. D.C. area, teacher of Church History at the Washington Baptist Seminary, instructor at Howard University's School of Divinity, devoted husband and father became the Interim Pastor of First Rising Mount Zion Baptist Church in July of 2012. At the time of his appointment, Rev. Green's leadership permeated a spirit of love, reconciliation, and healing. He was the right man, the right Pastor, at the right time for the congregation and for the Church as a whole! (To Be Continued). And let us not forget that "Our History Is Our Legacy".

BLACK HISTORY MONTH began as "Negro History Week," which was created in 1926 by Carter G. Woodson, a noted African American historian, scholar, educator, and publisher.
