

**CHURCH HISTORICAL NOTE #38:** On June 7, 1961; in Jackson, Mississippi, the Jail Number 20962 was issued to a Civil Rights' "Freedom Rider" who would spend the next twenty-nine (29) days in the Hinds' County Jail and Parchman Farm Penitentiary. And yet, fifty-one (51) years later; he would become the Interim Pastor for First Rising Mount Zion Baptist Church for four (4) years (July 1, 2012- June 3, 2016), after serving as Pastor for forty (40) years at Walker Memorial Baptist Church in Washington, D.C. Oh! what wonders God's plans have wrought for Reverend Reginald M. Green! (To Be Continued). And let us not forget that **"Our History Is Our Legacy."** 

**BLACK HISTORY MONTH** began as "Negro History Week," which was created in 1926 by Carter G. Woodson, a noted African American historian, scholar, educator, and publisher. It became a month-long celebration in 1976. The month of February was chosen to coincide with the birthdays of Frederick Douglass and Abraham Lincoln. The First Rising Black History Museum is now open and is located in the basement (blue room). Please come down and visit the museum.
