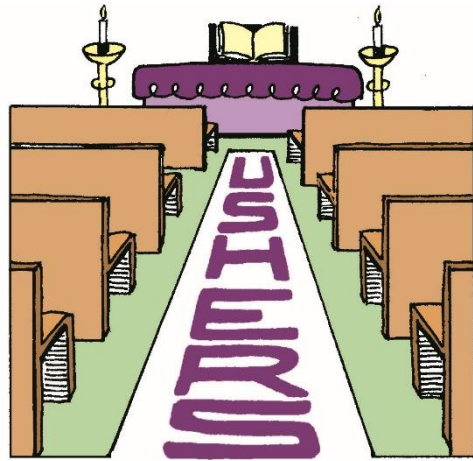

FINANCE OFFICE REMINDERS:

- (1) Requests should be submitted at least two weeks prior to the date the check is needed.
