I. The **Root** of Emptiness

- A. We are made into a <u>new</u> creation in Christ. (2 Cor. 5:17) [tricycle to Maserati]
- B. The <u>Holy Spirit</u> is given at the time of <u>salvation</u>. (Eph. 1:3)
- C. But we must regularly be <u>filled</u> with the Spirit. (Eph. 5:8)
- D. The <u>practice</u> of ministry/faith expends spiritual <u>energy</u>. (Luke 8:46)
- E. Without regular refueling, people begin to feel empty.

II. The Results of Emptiness

- A. Emptiness is dangerous to the spiritual life. ("lose heart" 2 Cor. 4:16-18)
- B. The <u>fruit</u> of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22,23) depend upon an ongoing <u>relationship</u> with the Holy Spirit. (like "remaining" in the vine John 15:5)
- C. Common indications of emptiness:
 - 1. Becoming <u>impatient</u> with God and people. (2 Tim. 1:7 "power of love...")
 - 2. Becoming <u>judgmental</u> due to lack of grace. (grace is "gift" from God Eph. 2:8)
 - 3. Becoming vulnerable to <u>temptation</u>. (Gal. 5:16 "walk the spirit...lust of flesh")

III. The Root of Refueling (Eph. 3:16)

A. **Receive** something from <u>God</u>.

"out of" = kata - According to His "glorious riches"

"Strengthen" = kratous - Passive acceptance to be <u>able to overcome</u>.

B. **Submit** to something from God's Holy Spirit

"Power" = dynamis - The ability to accomplish supernatural ministry

C. **Concentrate** on the "inner man"

Focusing on being rather than doing.

REFUEL = Receive, Submit, Concentrate
