

## I. The Confirmation of Miracles

- A. <u>Validation</u> of Christ's teaching
- B. <u>Confirmation</u> of Christ's deity (Luke 7:22)
- C. The <u>cost</u> of rejection (Luke 10:13)
- D. Jesus was the most prolific miracle worker in history (35-40)

## II. The Categories of Miracles

- 1. <u>Nature</u> (7+ times) Water to wine, calm storms, 2 catches of fish, coin in fish, withered fig, walking on water
- 2. <u>Bodily Healing (17+ times)</u> some with just a word, some with a touch, some that touch Him.
- 3. <u>Casting Out Demons (6+ times)</u> ekballism Ex. Gaderene Demoniac Lk. 8
- 4. Multiplication (2 times) Feedings of the 5000 and 4000 (Probably 20000)
- 5. Raising from the dead (3 times) Nain, Jarius, Lazarus
- 6. (Blow Your Mind!) <u>Messianic Miracles</u>: (Determined by Rabbis to be miracle that ONLY The Messiah could possibly do Jesus did ALL THREE)
  - A. Healing of <u>lepers</u> (Lk. 5:12) considered unclean therefore unhealable.
  - B. Dumb spirits (Matt. 12:22) can't communicate therefore unhealable.
  - C. Healing of people born blind (Jn. 9:1-12) brain is not healable.

## III. The Climax of Jesus' Earthly Ministry (Jn. 11:1 - 44)

- A. Jesus delays for a purpose (Jn. 11:6, 14)
- B. Jesus <u>declared</u> his point (Jn. 11:25) "I am" seven times in John
- C. Jesus <u>demonstrated</u> his compassion "Come and See" (Jn. 11:34,35)
- D. Jesus <u>demanded</u> a response of faith (Jn. 11:40) "do you believe this?"
- E. Jesus delivered a decisive proof (Jn. 11:41 44)- "that they might believe"
