2 Tim. 3:16,17

I. Precept - "God-breathed"

- A. <u>Inspired</u> by God = theopnuestos the out-breathing of God.
 - 1. The plenary <u>verbal</u> inspiration of God through the Spirit.
 - 2. The <u>full</u> and complete inspiration of scripture.
 - 3. The <u>original</u> documents (2 Peter 1:21) sail boats
- B. A decision has to be made 3 Options: (Psalm 1:1-6)
 - 1. <u>God</u> wrote the words therefore absolute authoritative.
 - 2. <u>Men</u> wrote the words with <u>God's</u> help only some authoritative.
 - 3. <u>Men</u> wrote their words <u>about</u> God none authoritative.
- C. The Apostle Paul's and WellSpring's decisions.
 - 1. The Bible is <u>The Word of God!</u>
 - 2. The Bible is the <u>authority</u> in all decisions!
 - 3. <u>Learning</u> the Bible is a <u>priority!</u>

II. "Profitable" = ophelimos - useful, helpful, and pleasing to God

- A. <u>"Teaching"</u> = didaskolia About <u>our</u> learning.
- B. <u>"Reproof"</u> = elgmos To recognize <u>our</u> failings. (Heb. 4:12)
- C. "Correction" = epanothosis To show us our right path.
- D. <u>"Training"</u> = padeia The development of <u>our</u> character. in <u>"righteousness"</u> = dikiosyne = acceptance/pleasing to God.

III. Purposeful - "So That..." (2 Tim. 3:14,15)

- A. "thoroughly" = artios specifically fitted prepared
- B. <u>"equipped"</u> = exartizo empowered to complete the task
- C. <u>"good work"</u> = agathos ergon The works God has called for you to do. (Eph. 2:10)
