

I. Practical's About Hearing

A. Ask if this is God's voice.

Four Voices: Worldly Wisdom, Flesh, Devil, and God

- B. Does this contradict scripture?
- C. Do you have the "peace" principle? (The Holy Spirit convicts/gives peace)
- D. Does your mentor have peace?
- E. Does this lead you to more <u>faith</u>? (Heb. 11:6a)

II. Potter's House Illustration (Jer. 18:1-12)

- A. The <u>destruction</u> of Jerusalem is still in the <u>balance</u> (God's heart Jer. 29:11).
- B. God is the potter and can remake/reform the nation if they will repent!
- C. The people <u>rejected</u> the word of the prophet. (vs. 12 "their own ways").

III. Proclamation on the Trash Dump (Jeremiah 19:1 - 10)

- A. <u>Water poured out (represents the wrath of God).</u>
- B. At Gehenna (Valley of Ben Hennon) Place of evil activities and death.
- C. Pot <u>destroyed</u> as a sign of God's finality on His discipline.

IV. Program with Zedekiah (Jeremiah 37:3;38:14)

- A. Jeremiah <u>prophesies</u> with Zedekiah multiple times.
- B. The <u>destruction</u> of Jerusalem will come.
- C. Egypt will <u>fail</u> you and the Babylonians will <u>return</u>.
- D. <u>Last</u> chance for Zedekiah and the people of <u>Judah</u> ("surrender").
- E. 19 months of siege leads to the destruction of <u>Jerusalem</u>.

V. Possible Applications

- A. Jeremiah head the voice of God as he went obey what you know.
- B. The people of Judah <u>refused</u> to heed the words of God "stiffnecked"
- C. The prophet in our lives is the Holy Spirit. (John 16:13)
