

I. His Fire in the Bones is the Word of God(20:8,9)

- A. God said, "I have put my word in your mouth" (1:9)
- B. To Hear = the call to $\underline{\text{Speak}}$ (Rom. 10:8)
- C. The Great Commission (1) Prophet part "Go" "proclaim" (Matt. 28:19,20)
 - (2) Priest part "baptize" "teach"

II. His Fire in the Bones is the **Compassion** of God

- A. Jeremiah is known as the weeping prophet. (Lam. 3:48-51)
- B. The <u>process</u> of passion
 - 1. The <u>word</u> of God compels us.
 - 2. A <u>burden</u> develops as the Holy Spirit <u>leads</u> us.
 - 3. The truth becomes a burning fire. (I Cor. 9:16)

III. His Fire was not Extinguished by Fear (20:7; 11a)

- A. Fear of the cost (pride)
- B. Fear of being wrong (doubt)
- C. Fear of not knowing what to say (doubt)
- D. Too busy talking and doing to care (self)
