

I. Three Truths to Bear (Psalm 127:3-5)

"gift" = (nachalah) = a possession of <u>God</u> given as a <u>Trust</u> to us.

- A. Our Children are God's first.
- B. Children are given as a <u>steward's</u> gift. (Matt. 25:14–30)
 - 1. <u>Manage</u> God's resources care/protect/honor
 - 2. <u>Maximize</u> their potential multiply/increase/develop
 - 3. Accountable to the Master a day of reckoning
- C. Parenting is a <u>Dynamic Process</u> similar to growing a <u>Vineyard</u>
 - 1. Commander
 - 2. Coach
 - 3. Counselor
 - 4. Consultant

II. Three Hats to Wear (Prov. 22:6)

"Train up" = (chanak) = to <u>sharpen</u> and to <u>dedicate to God</u>
"the way" = (derek) = along a <u>journey</u>; the <u>manner</u> of life.

A. Groundskeeper

- 1. Setting the <u>boundaries</u> of play
- 2. Explaining the <u>rules</u> and <u>expectations</u> of the game

B. Referee

- 1. <u>Involved</u> in every play
- 2. Keeping everybody in <u>line</u> and on <u>schedule</u>
- 3. <u>Enforcing</u> the rules <u>consistently</u>

C. Coach

- 1. Setting the <u>vision</u> for the team
- 2. Maximizing each players unique potential
- 3. Defining the win
