

I. Thomas and Saul's Problem - Their Paradigms

- A. A "Paradigm" is a framework of what your believe to be <u>**Truth**</u>.
- B. Everyone has a paradigm about <u>Who</u> Jesus is!
- C. Thomas was a **<u>Believer</u>** and Saul was an <u>**Unbeliever**</u>.
- D. Both will need **<u>Personal</u>** proof to challenge their paradigm.

II. Christ's Presence - His Personal Proof

- A. Christ <u>Appeared</u> to both of these men.
- B. Causing a paradigm <u>Shift</u> causing <u>Doubt</u>
- C. Doubt is the **Doorway** to **True** faith!

III. Christ's Promise - His Goal

- A. You can <u>Know</u> you can <u>Act</u> like a believer
- B. Doubt leads to a <u>**Crisis**</u> of faith wrestling with <u>**Truth**</u>

IV. Personal Profession - New Paradigm

- A. Thomas = "my **Lord** and my **<u>God</u>**"
- B. Paul = Gal. 2:20 = "I am <u>**Crucified**</u> with Christ..."

<u>v.</u> The Process of Saving Faith

- A. Confronting their paradigm with <u>**Truth**</u>
- B. Share your personal **<u>Doubts</u>** and **<u>Struggles</u>** with truth
- C. Being the **<u>Personal</u>** presence of Christ
- D. Inviting them to **Experience** truth
 - i. The living <u>Word</u> of God the <u>Only</u> real truth
 - ii. Communicating with God through **<u>Prayer</u>**
 - iii. Active <u>**Part**</u> in the "<u>**Body**</u> of Christ" communion
- E. Guide them into a **<u>Relationship</u>** with Christ through the <u>**Holy Spirit**</u>.
