

I. The Purpose of the Tongue (3:9a)

- A. $\underline{\text{Bless}}$ God! (eu + logea = $\underline{\text{well}}$ + $\underline{\text{speak}}$)
- B. <u>Ways</u> we Bless God
 - 1. Praises "Lord"
 - 2. Prayers "Father"
 - 3. <u>Proclamations</u> "Savior"
- C. Ways we <u>Blaspheme</u> God (3:9b)
 - 1. <u>Cursing people</u> made in his image (Gen. 1:27)
 - 2. Curse God as well
- D. We Should Not do this! (vs. 10)
 - 1. <u>Comparison</u> (bless vs curse)
 - 2. <u>Cooperation</u> (same mouth!)
 - 3. <u>Comment!</u> This should not to be! (chre)

II. Three Pictures of Consistency (3:11,12)

- A. A <u>Fountain</u> gushing flow
- B. A <u>Fig tree</u> bear <u>olives</u> <u>grapevine</u> bear figs?
- C. <u>Fresh water</u> does not come from a <u>salt water pool!</u>
- D. One time = $\underline{\text{Hypocrisy}}$ invalidates the $\underline{\text{whole}}$ truth

III. The Proof of the Tongue (vs. 13 - 18)

- A. Two <u>wisdoms</u> (natures) <u>active</u> in us all! (Gal. 5:16 25)
 - 1. <u>Earthly</u> wisdom (Carnal nature)
 - i. Bitter <u>envy</u> ii. <u>Selfish</u> ambition iii. <u>Unspiritua</u>l iv. Of the <u>devil</u>
 - 2. <u>Heavenly</u> wisdom (Spiritual nature)
 - i. good life ii. deeds done in humility (vs. 13)
 - iii. Pure iv. Peace-loving v. Considerate vi. Submissive
 - vii. Full of Mercy viii. Good fruit ix. Impartial x. Sincere
- B. Our tongues are the <u>proof</u> of which nature is <u>ruling!</u>
- C. Our <u>goal</u>: Psalm 19:14 May these <u>words</u> of my mouth and this <u>meditation</u> of my heart be <u>pleasing</u> in your sight, LORD, my Rock and my Redeemer.
