Old Testament Prophecies

1. Preparation

Mal. 4:5 - "See, I will send the prophet Elijah to you before that great and dreadful day of the Lord comes.

Zech. 14 - A day of the Lord is coming, Jerusalem, when your possessions will be plundered and divided up within your very walls.

2. Reward

Obad. 1:15 - "The day of the LORD is near for all nations.

As you have done, it will be done to you; your deeds will return upon your own head.

Isa. 40:10 - See, the Sovereign LORD comes with power, and he rules with a mighty arm.

See, his reward is with him, and his recompense accompanies him.

3. Signs

Psalm 50:3 - Our God comes and will not be silent; a fire devours before him, and around him a tempest rages.

Isa. 13:10 - The stars of heaven and their constellations will not show their light.

The rising sun will be darkened and the moon will not give its light.

4. Glory

Psalm 102:16 When the Lord shall build up Zion, he shall appear in his glory.

Isa. 60:2 For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the Lord shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.

5. Deliverance of Believers

Job 19:25 For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth:

Zech. 2:3 Thy dead men shall live, together with my dead body shall they arise. Awake and sing, ye that dwell in dust: for thy dew is as the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead.

6. Judgement/Wrath

Isa. Jer. Ezek.

Joel 1:15 Alas for the day! for the day of the Lord is at hand, and as a destruction from the Almighty shall it come.

Joel 2:11 And the Lord shall utter his voice before his army: for his camp is very great: for he is strong that executeth his word: for the day of the Lord is great and very terrible; and who can abide it?

New Testament Promises

James 5:7 - Be patient, then, brothers and sisters, until the Lord's coming. See how the farmer waits for the land to yield its valuable crop, patiently waiting for the autumn and spring rains

I John 2:28 ²⁸ And now, dear children, continue in him, so that when he appears we may be confident and unashamed before him at his coming.

Titus 2:13 ¹³ while we wait for the blessed hope—the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ,

Heb. 10:25 ²⁵ not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as <u>you see the Day approaching</u>.

Matt. 16:27 For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person according to what they have done.

Mark 8:38 If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of them when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels."
