Matt. 6:1-4

Be Aware Of Your Motives (Matt. 6:1) I.

- "Be <u>Careful</u>" Beware A.
- "Acts of Righteousness" ministry piety = acts of reverence to God В.
 - 1. Piety is not to be <u>hidden</u>
 - 2. Radical simplicity does not mean separation from reality! (salt/light Matt. 5:12-16)
- C. "to be seen"/"to be honored by men" (doxa = glory)
 - 1. Why do we give? Give glory to God or receive glory from men
 - 2. The heart of the matter
- D. Reward – (apecho = full receipt)
 - 1. You cannot receive a reward from heaven AND from earth
 - 2. Your treasure is where your heart is (Matt. 6:19 21)
 - 3. Truly I say unto you exclamation point!

Be Aware of Your Ministry (Matt. 6:2-4) II.

- "So when you give..." (vs. 2a,3a)

 - Giving is not optional it is a command! (I John 3:17)
 It is an outward practice based on an inward perception (2 Cor. 8)
 - 3. Will we be like the <u>Dead Sea</u> or the <u>Sea of Galilee</u>?
- Two "do nots" B.
 - 1. Make a scene as the hypocrites do!
 - "seen" = theatomi = theatre = to <u>watch</u> a show/concentrate on the people a.
 - "hypocrites" = hupokritase = to put on an act in front of people b.
 - 2. Keep score with others
 - "know" Right hand person and left hand person power people in your lives a.
 - We love to brag about what we do and what we give b.
- Three things to do C.
 - 1. Keep it secret
 - 2. Refuse human rewards/praise
 - 3. Long for The Father's rewards

K. I. S. S. (Keep It Simple Saints)

- 1. Buy things for their usefulness rather than their status.
- 2. Reject anything that produces an addiction in you.
- 3. Develop a habit of giving things away.
- 4. Reject everything that hinders you from "seeking first the Kingdom of God"
