We will depart for Gatlinburg at 12:30 on Sunday, August 6. **BE PREPARED TO LEAVE AT 12:30!** This means you need to have all bags packed on the vehicles prior to this time. If you plan to travel in anything other than the clothes you wore to church, you need to bring them with you to church.

All meals will be provided, including those during travel. The only money needed will be optional spending money for shopping on Monday. Each day will include quiet time for personal scripture study, large group worship meetings, small group discussion time, and free time. For the majority of the trip students will not have their cell phones. All electronics devices will be collected and stored in a secure, locked container. All chaperones will have cell phones with them at all times in case you need to reach your student. Students will be given an opportunity to call home every day. If you choose not to send your child with a phone, one will be made available to them each day. There will be portions of the trip where we are outside of cell phone coverage. If an emergency should arise while we are unreachable, leave a voicemail and send a text message. As soon as we receive these we will find an area where contact can be made.
