Here are a few suggested items: Cleaning supplies, toilet paper, laundry soap, paper towels, dishes, bath towels and wash clothes, kitchen utensils, furniture, rugs, lamps, non-perishable food items and drinks, small kitchen appliances, shampoo, bath soap, rolls of quarters for laundry, vinegar for cleaning clothes damaged by smoke, storage bins/totes,

Clothing: Miguel wears 42x32 pants and 2x shirt, Rebecca wears an XL blouse and size 10 pants, and Luis wears 36x39 in pants or 36 in shorts and XL T-shirt.
