Christ United Methodist Preschool is licensed by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services. The license, number 402568, is posted in the Preschool Office.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF AGENCY:

The preschool is in session from the last week of August to December and January to May. The child/staff ratio is 12 children per teacher in age appropriate classes. We have 2 or 3 classroom teachers, depending on community need, and 1 activities teacher.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The child must be 3 years old by August 1st of the school year. Each child must be <u>completely</u> potty-trained (not wearing a pull-up and able to care for themselves in the bathroom), have all forms complete, and have a current physical by the first day of school, listing all current immunizations.

GEOGRAPHIC AREA SERVED: Baltimore and surrounding communities

SPECIFIC SERVICES:

The purpose of the preschool will be to:

- 1. Serve as an outreach to children of preschool age.
- 2. Provide each child an opportunity to be with and learn with other children in a Christian atmosphere conducive to learning.
- 3. Provide a disciplined structure with a loving, friendly environment which would foster creative learning for preschool age children.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$50.00 (non-refundable)

SUPPLY FEE: \$35.00 (due at the beginning of the school year) MILK FEE: \$60.00 (due at the beginning of the school year)

TUITION 2018 - 2019 SCHOOL YEAR: \$990.00 per year (payable in 9 payments of \$110.00)
