We had 14 members at our February 10th meeting. The following is an overview of the actions/reports that were taken/given during this meeting.

- Cheryl Fey, Worship chair, reported the Ash Wednesday service is a community service to be held at Thurston UMC. We will be having a Maundy Thursday service at our church. The Good Friday service is also a community service. The men's group will be serving breakfast Easter morning. 1st Sunday Supper has been averaging 35-40 people.
- 2. Outreach and Missions chair, Jim Thompson, reported via e-mail about a couple possible mission projects. One would be to help local people getting out of jail get personal hygiene items and an out of state mission to help raise funds for the Tree of Life in South Dakota for a new kitchen and eating area.
- 3. Jerry McCreery, Finance chair, reported we have raised \$99,150 for the mortgage reduction fund. We are planning to host an event after we reach our goal. The church audit is underway.
- 4. Joe Farmer, SPPRC chair, handed out highlights of their meeting. It included a plan for staff evaluations and that Mary Johnson will be their representative on the Pre-School board. Joe had talked to Pastor Brian Straub, our interim pastor about what he is going to be responsible of while here.
- 5. Jim Anderson, Trustees co-chair, reported many projects have been completed around the church and parsonage. Saturday, May 16th is Trustee work day from 8 am to noon. Everyone is invited to come and help. The trustees are looking into a new sign for the front of the church.
- 6. In other business, Sheila Burns said **we need a VBS director** for our church as soon as possible. The community VBS leaders will be meeting soon to start planning for VBS, which is not at our church this year. Tim Lawlis said we need to reach out to families that are no longer coming to our church to find out why and what we can do to become better.

I would like to thank everyone that attended for their dedication and leadership to our church. Our next meeting is Monday, April 13th at 7:00 pm in Fellowship Hall.

We are still searching for members to help on different committees. You can make a difference. We need input, ideas and help. It is never too late to step up.

In addition to paying for their meals, our guest organizations paid \$542.50 in building rental.


After the meal expenses were paid, 100% of the profit -\$7,431.33 went to the church; 10% to the church for operating expenses - \$674.53 and 90% to the mortgage principal - \$6,756.80.

Since we organized in January 2011 we have served 13,582 guests and raised \$101,058 for the church.


