Notes from the Message:

Make it REAL!

How can YOU make God's Word REAL in YOUR life?

1. Read Ephesians 2:1-10. Because we are all sinners (Rom. 3:23), we all deserve judgment (Rom. 6:23). However, because God loves us so much, he doesn't want to spend eternity without us. Therefore he sacrificed his Son, Jesus, to take the punishment for our sin, and chose, instead, to give us grace (unconditional love and forgiveness that we don't deserve). Have you received God's grace? If not, step down off the throne of your heart, confess your sin, turn from it, and ask Jesus to be on the throne of your heart. Receive God's love and forgiveness—and then live the life he calls you to live in Christ (Col. 3:12-17).

2. Read Eph. 4:31-32. Is there someone you need to forgive? Someone against whom you hold bitterness, anger, a grudge, or unforgiveness? You may think they don't deserve forgiveness, but do you? God forgives you though you don't deserve it, and he expects us to do the same for others. Pray and ask God's help to forgive and shine his love and grace through you.
