Do you know your prayers? Recently, I had conversations with Monsignor Chiodo and Fr. Gehler, about this year's First Reconciliation for the SAS (St. Anthony School) and PRE (Parish Religious Education) kids. One of the comments I heard about both groups was that the kids really struggled with their prayers. They didn't seem to have the basic prayers memorized. In reflecting over this, I keep coming back to the same thought. Learning these prayers needs to happen at home, as well as the classroom. But then I wonder if the parents know the prayers. My guess is that many of the parents didn't memorize the prayers themselves, and therefore rely on the teachers and catechists to teach the children. I was thinking that a great practice for this Lent would be memorizing those prayers in your home, with your children. Most grandmas and grandpas know the prayers, and I encourage you all to work with your grandchildren. Saying these prayers every day of Lent will bring your family close, and you will all grow your relationship with God.
