Reconciliation: (Confession): Sat. 9-9:30am, 3:30-4pm or by appointment.

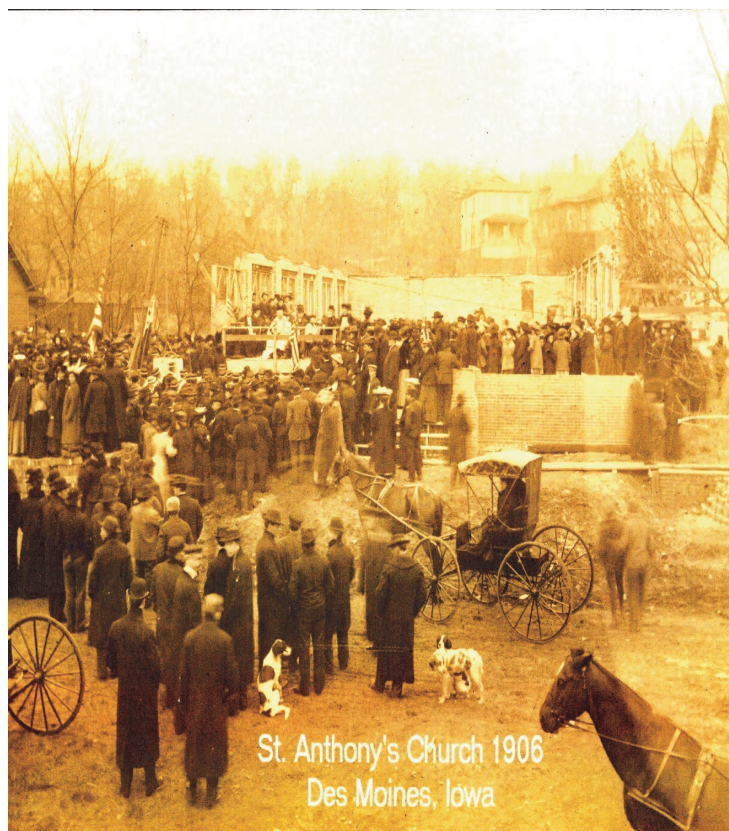

Can you believe we will soon be taking registrations for next year's Faith Formation classes? We will! In the elevator foyer, and on the website, you'll soon find registration forms for Parish Religious Education and Confirmation. PRE is for anyone who doesn't attend Catholic school. (But you can still join us, even if you do!) We have classes for K-8, and meet every Sunday morning from 9:45-11:15 in the school. We also do First Communion and Reconciliation preparation for those in 2nd grade and above. If you are a member of this church, but not at St. Anthony School, your kids should be in PRE every year. Let us help you teach them about their faith! Confirmation class meets every other Wednesday for one year and is for anyone entering 9th grade or above. These programs will both begin in September, and the schedules will be posted soon. Blessings!

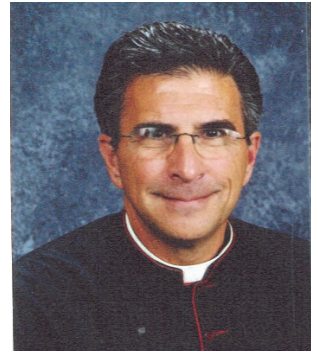
