Reconciliation: (Confession): Sat. 9-9:30am, 3:30-4pm or by appointment.



Skills and/or abilities desired, but not required, include able to lift or move heavy objects, work in inclement weather conditions, basic electrical and plumbing knowledge, and able to operate basic tools and equipment needed to perform the job. Must be able to take initiative, communicate effectively, and work independently. Related experience is desirable. Resumes may be sent to Fr. 
