Reconciliation: (Confession): Sat. 9-9:30am, 3:30-4pm or by appointment.



Phyllis Davis Annual Memorial Linen Drive





My Dear Parishioners,

This is Divine Mercy weekend. In the 1930's, a Polish nun named Sr. Faustina was given the privilege of seeing THE LORD JESUS appear to her. The Lord requested a feast in honor of His Divine Mercy and urged her to promote a fervent devotion to His Mercy by the faithful. I encourage you to say this chaplet—rosary of Divine Mercy daily. Three o'clock is the ideal time for this—during that hour of mercy when Christ died on the cross. If not, anytime is appropriate to say this powerful prayer. I say it daily, and it has been a blessing for me. The meaning of this feast is found in the 'signature' words at the bottom of the picture icon of Divine Mercy—"Jesus I trust in You." We will have a procession to our grotto, dedicated to Divine Mercy, after the 11:30 Sunday Mass this Sunday. At the grotto we will have the solemn singing of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. Join us.

A beautiful celebration of the Easter mysteries last weekend. Attendance was inspiring. We welcomed 15 new members into our church. We welcome them and pray for their continued growth as members of our family.

I encourage you to begin to use this Chaplet prayer as a daily prayer.

1. Begin with the Sign of the Cross, 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary and The Apostles Creed.
2. Then on the Our Father Beads say the following:
Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
3. On the 10 Hail Mary Beads say the following:
For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
(Repeat step 2 and 3 for all five decades).
4. Conclude with *(three times)*:
Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world
