


Marriage: At least one of the parties must be registered and a practicing member of the parish. Please contact the office at least 8 months prior to the proposed date of the wedding.





Friends,

This day is one of the most precious days for us at St. Anthony. It is Corpus Christi weekend. Since the early days of the last century, this feast day found thousands of faithful southsiders lining the streets and joining in the procession of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Once again we will gather for Mass at the grotto at 11:00AM Sunday and will march in procession to five altars throughout the neighborhood. We will be one in spirit with those faithful souls—now gone—who once marched along these hallowed roads throughout the years.



At Fatima, an angel appeared to the three visionaries who saw the Blessed Mother in 1917. The angel asked the children to entreat people to pray in reparation for the indifference, apathy and sacrilege against the true presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. The following prayer was given to the children—after praying it—there at Fatima. We offer this prayer today on Corpus Christi weekend in reparation for those of our families and friends who have denied the Lord due adoration in the Blessed Sacrament—especially by not coming on Sundays to the Mass.
