**Parish Library:** Please visit the parish library next to the church located in the elevator foyer. The library is open everyday and books are available for check out.

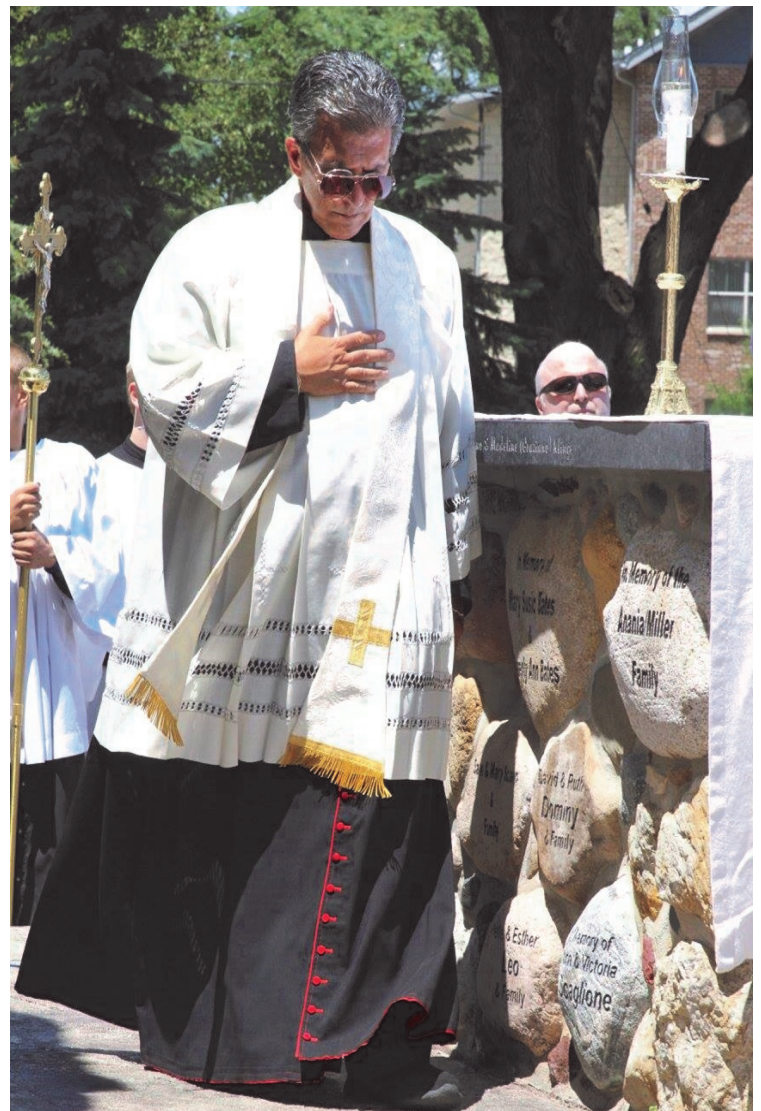

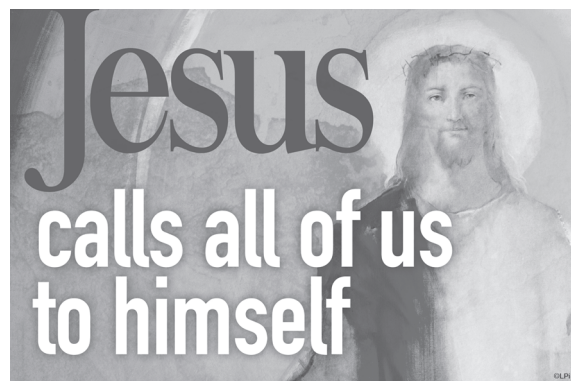

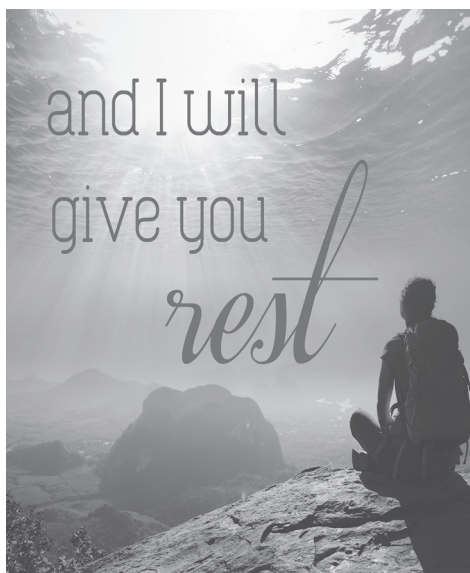
