Natural Family Planning Classes

The next three-part series of classes on the sympto-thermal method of natural family planning is scheduled to begin **Monday, October 2 from 6 to 8:30 p.m.** at Games & More (Valley West Mall, West Des Moines). Cost is a one-time fee of \$130 for all course materials, classes, one year of consultation with certified instructors, plus a one-year digital subscription to Family Foundations magazine and CycleProGo digital charting. CCL also offers two supplementary classes designed to help couples with natural family planning during post-partum and pre-menopause. The sympto-thermal method of natural family planning uses a cross-checking system based on three signs of fertility and is 99 percent effective in postponing pregnancy when used properly. It is also highly effective in helping couples of low fertility achieve pregnancy. 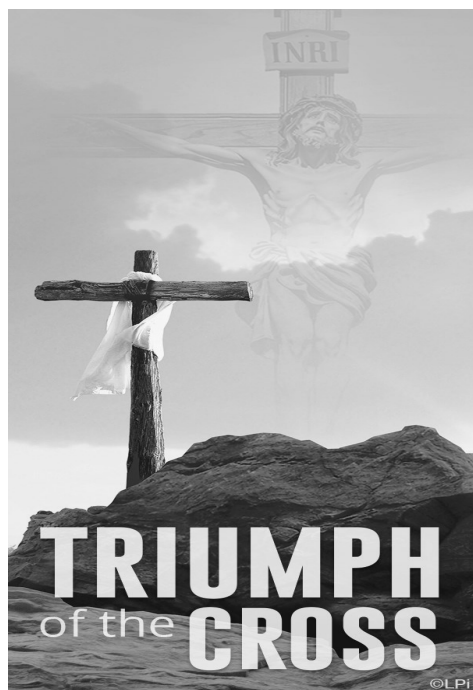

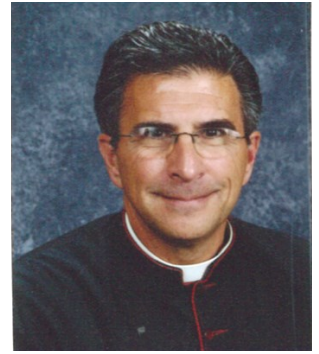
