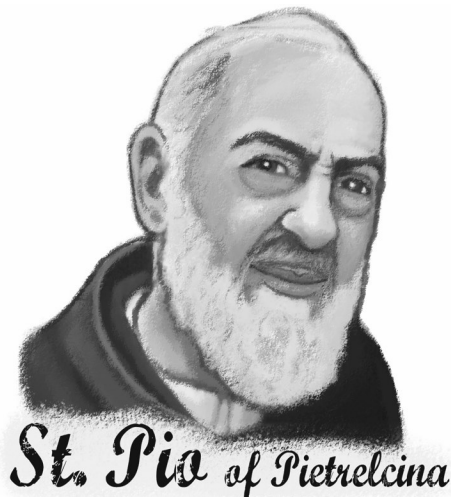

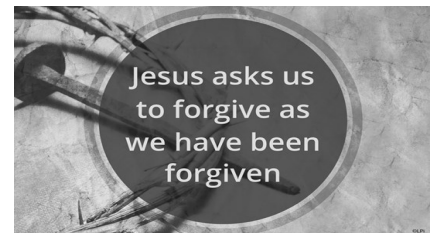

Friends,

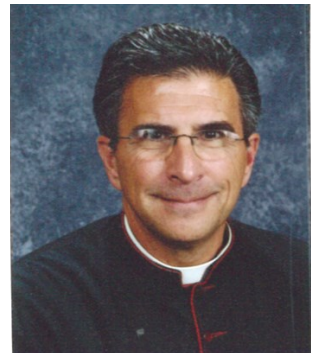
