Reconciliation: (Confession): Sat. 9-9:30am, 3:30-4pm or by appointment.

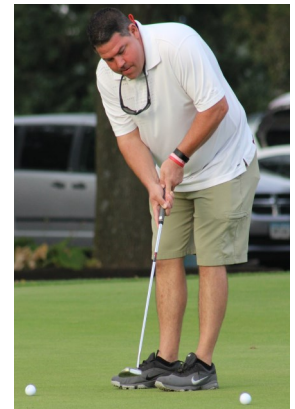

Greetings to you,

I hope you've enjoyed our discussion of the book, "The Benedict Option." We've been publishing the video to our Facebook page and you can watch it at your leisure, or watch it live on Thursdays at 10.

On a related note, I'd like to invite you to the next study we are having, starting later this month. The program is called, "Who Am I to Judge?" and is written by Edward Sri. There will be a 30 minute video, followed by a discussion. The workbook costs \$16 and I am happy to order it for you! Read this description, from their website:

How do we talk about morality in a world that no longer believes in truth? When we're bombarded with messages of "Be tolerant!" "Don't judge!" and "Coexist!" many good people feel afraid to say anything is right or wrong anymore.

This 8-part study program gives us an important key to responding to relativism effectively—a Catholic moral worldview. Learn how Catholic morality is all about love, how making a judgment is not judging a person's soul, and how, in the words of Pope Francis, "relativism wounds people" and is "the spiritual poverty of our times."

We will meet for 8 sessions on Tuesdays from 6:30-8, beginning October 24th. We will take breaks for the holidays. If you have any questions, call or email me. 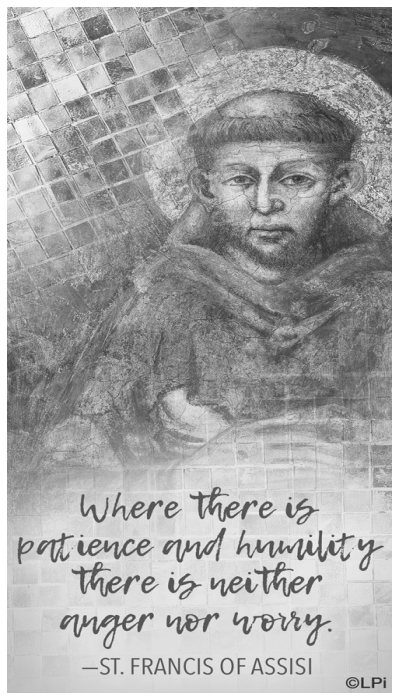

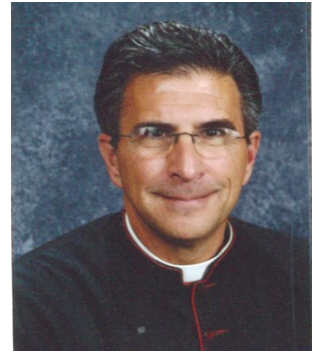
