Prepare the way!

Hello, friends. Happy Second Sunday of Advent, year B. Doesn't sound very festive when I say it that way, does it? And yet, these readings today are so dramatic and wonderful and important! Let's take a look and a listen today, and really open our hearts and minds to what God wants to tell us. For example, what does it mean to us in today's world, to "prepare the way?" What can we do? We can certainly talk with our family and friends about the meaning of this season. We can decorate our homes or yards with a nativity scene instead of, or in addition to, a Santa or reindeer. I encourage you all to focus this week on preparing the way for Christ in your home, but especially in your heart. Take those few precious minutes and give them to Christ. Read a scripture and just sit with it in your heart. Invite the Lord to sit with you and really experience that closeness. Do it in the church or the chapel, or even in your home or office. Anywhere you can sit still for a few minutes and just breathe. Prepare your heart this week, as we get closer to the coming of our Messiah.
